He has over 2 decades of continuous support as PI from the NIH for clinical and translational research in Staphylococcus aureus and other antibiotic-resistant bacterial infections. Dr. Fowler created the S. aureus Bacteremia Group, co-founded the International Collaboration on Endocarditis, and has been the Contact PI of the Antibacterial Resistance Leadership Group since its inception in 2014. He has over 350 peer-reviewed publications with >33,000 citations.
