He was a member of the Steering Committee for the Adaptive designs CONSORT Extension (ACE) Project, an extension to the CONsolidated Standards of Reporting Trials (CONSORT) Statement for adaptive clinical trials. Dr. Hamasaki is an elected member of International Statistical Institute, a fellow of the ASA and the Society for Clinical Trials.
